
- The fellowship and networking opportunities to connect first hand with leaders in the industry!

Back then we used film for everything and we processed all black & white at the school in a very small 4ft x 5ft darkroom closet.

I really didn't know what I was doing at the time and processed my very first roll of film and used photo print stop bath by accident which ate the emulsion off the film

I'll never know if those photos



Soon I was photographing every school event and the yearbook and school newspaper was littered with nothing by my photographs. I spent more time processing film and printing photos in the dark room than I did any other class at school. I would help out my instructor photograph parties and events including weddings.


It wasn't long until he asked me if I wanted to photograph a wedding on my own. I agreed to do the wedding saying, "sure as long as they don't expect much." I was able to use the school equipment, two medium format Mamiya 645 cameras. The clients covered the cost for the film and processing and paid me \$125.00 to photograph the wedding. My mom had to drop me off and pick me up because I was only 15 years old at the time.

And thus, my photography career began ..

After I received my first merits I made a personal goal for myself. I wanted to earn my Master's Degree by the time I was 40. Well I turned 40 in 2018 and I'm happy to say I get my Master's Degree in January 2019 in Atlanta! I couldn't think of a more suitable sponsor than the person who started me on this path years ago, so I am proud to have Tracy VanZeeland stand by my side while I receive my degree. I have had many mentors along the way, one of the most important being my girlfriend and fellow photographer and WPPA member, Krystal Lamberty. 




get to know you, your family, and your style so we can collaborate together to create great work.




I studied the technical side of photography through many course hours. Starting out with a degree from Madison College and furthering my education by earning my Master of Photography degree through the Professional Photographers of America.




## Photographer of the Year Combined

This my friends is what membership in the WPPA has been to me. This is what it can do for you but first you have to ask.



Macro is always fun. Learning the tools that you may need to create a good image is a good idea. Studying others that do macro is one of the things that I do, learning different techniques to try.

It helps when you plant your own flowers and wait for them to bloom. Then it is creation time.

I recommend using a tripod when you can. I use focus bracketing when there is a need. You need to keep everything in focus. Sometimes I use my Canon EF 100mm f/2.8L, or I use my canon EF100-400. Add a few extension tubes and you are all set.

Keep learning and practice, practice, practice.

Volunteers are truly the lifeblood of PPA and its Affiliates. Every association has those extraordinary volunteers whose efforts on behalf of the Affiliate and its members deserve special recognition. Seeking a way to thank these individuals PPA created the National Award in 1958. The National Award is offered by PPA to state, regional, national and international affiliated organizations on a yearly basis. The award recognizes those who generously contribute their time and talents to the service of their profession, their affiliated organization and their fellow photographers.

Selections of the award are determined by the recipient's peers, adding to its distinction and value.

The highest honor granted by a PPA Affiliate, it recognizes those whose support for photography goes far beyond any regular expectations or contributions. The simple inscription on this plaque reads "for service to professional photography" – but we know that this award means far more than that.

This award may be given to a member or a non-member, or to someone outside of the field of photography. The only restrictions are that the individual must have performed outstanding service to the profession of photography and that no individual may receive more than one National Award from the same group.



I received my PPA Masters Degree in 1994.


I have 2 daughters and 2 grandsons and will become a grandparent again in August.
